







How do I add a mini-map to the MyHouse panel in v3.4?

Any data with geo-spatial co-ordinates can be displayed within a panel on the MyHouse page and the data can be extracted from many sources.

This mini-tutorial will show how to extract data directly from a database and use it to display a property's UPRN and a mini-map of the location in one of these panels in MyHouse.

This operation is performed as follows:

Description	Example
<p>1) Create a new layer - in this instance a virtual layer as we will not be using data from a shp/tab file as provided by the map-files (eg base.map)</p> <p>This is done, as shown opposite, by right-clicking on an appropriate layer and selecting "Add New Virtual Layer"</p>	
<p>2) Give the layer a name that reflects the general nature of the data that will be presented. In this instance we will call it Property Details as we will be displaying data relevant to the currently selected property.</p>	
<p>At the bottom of the 'layer properties' page for Virtual Layers we have a panel called Row Settings that we can use for creating the content for the layer as it will be displayed on the page.</p> <p>Any (valid) HTML can be used to create content and rows can be added, removed and re-positioned using the '+', 'X' and arrow buttons respectively.</p> <p>Click on the '+' button to open the dialogue to add content.</p>	
<p>3) HTML for adding the UPRN</p> <pre data-bbox="151 1612 1141 1654"><p>Unique Property Reference Number (UPRN): ##uid##</p></pre> <p>##UniqueId## will be substituted for the UPRN of the property.</p> <p>4) HTML for adding the USRN</p> <pre data-bbox="151 1814 1141 1856"><p>Unique Street Reference Number (USRN): ##parentuid##</p></pre> <p>##parentuid## will be substituted for the USRN of the property.</p>	

5) HTML for adding the mini-map

[MapSource] should be set to the main Map-source (as shown)
##easting## & **##northing##** will be substituted for the property's co-ordinates

IMPORTANT NOTE **&** will be translated to a regular ampersand. It should be used in its HTML form (as given here), otherwise it will not be translated properly when the HTML is written out to create the image link.
